Technique time includes: plies, releves, porta bra, tendu, piques, grande battements, and tonlea. Across the floor techniques include: emboite (reindeer prances), and Grande jete (leaps). We'll enjoy "Being & Doing" - a pantomime activity and 2 different movement stories. Ask your young dancer about class and their favorite activities!
